MULTIPLE FULL TIME, PERMANENT POSITIONS

The OAG supports a career path to a CPA designation and is an approved CPA training office. The OAG enables employees to succeed in their academic studies by providing a work schedule that supports both education and work commitments. The OAG also provides financial supports for the costs of successfully completed CPA modules, exam preparation sessions and the CPA final examination. Successful candidates must be enrolled, or be willing to enroll, in the CPA program and also commit to progressing through successive courses in a timely manner.

Duties:

As a member of our Financial Audit Team, you will assist in the execution of an audit plan. Under the guidance of a senior auditor, you will collect and analyse information to determine the accuracy, completeness and conformance to auditing and accounting principles, practices and standards. You will assist with financial statement audits of varying complexity and team sizes, always ensuring that assigned work is accurate and meets required deadlines.

Considerable professional interaction with client staff and colleagues is required to develop productive work relationships that enable the timely release of audit reports. Other related duties will be performed as required.

Screening Criteria:

1. Eligible to enroll in the Core Module 1 of the Canadian Chartered Professional Accountant Designation Program at the CPA Atlantic School of Business program by September 2026 (submission of a university transcript proving completion of all prerequisite courses may be required during the recruitment process)
2. Experience in auditing (asset)
3. Related experience in the public sector (asset)

Assessment Criteria:

1. Knowledge of Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles and Canadian Generally Accepted Auditing Standards
2. Knowledge of the operation of the provincial public service (asset)
3. Ability to communicate effectively
4. Ability to exercise sound judgment

5. Ability to work independently
6. Establish and maintain effective working relationships
7. Ability to take initiative
